

## **STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE - 1.4.1**

### **TOPIC - ALARM RESPONSE - DISPATCH DIVISIONS - GENERAL**

#### **PURPOSE:**

To establish reasonable response areas within the District allowing for better total coverage for the District.

#### **GENERAL:**

The district is divided into three areas for response and dispatch purposes. The general idea is to provide adequate coverage while reducing the number of times an individual might be alerted for calls out of their respective area on a first alarm basis.

#### **GUIDELINES:**

The three divisions are defined as follows:

"A" Division - Hwy. 126 from Noti, at the West, to Central Rd., at the East (including Cantrell & Halderson Rds.); Territorial Rd. from Hwy. 126, at the North, to Doane Rd., at the South; Vaughn Rd. from Noti to Territorial Rd.; Central Rd. from Territorial Rd. to Hwy. 126; Crow Rd. from Territorial Rd. to the Petzold Rd., Erickson Rd. intersection; Wolf Creek Rd. to mile post 7, including Panther Creek Rd.; Battle Creek Rd. including El Dale Rd.; all properties, roads, drives, and lanes within the described area.

"B" Division - All properties, roads, drives, and lanes predominately to the North and West of Division "A".

"C" Division - All properties, roads, drives, and lanes predominately to the South, East, and Southwest of Division "A".

Apparatus from each division will be assigned for first alarm duty based upon the nature and location of the call.
