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STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE - 3.1.4

TOPIC – ISSUED APPAREL

PURPOSE:

To identify the timelines and types of apparel the District will issue.

GENERAL:

To promote professionalism and the desire to advance, the district will issue apparel to individuals throughout their career. In line with District Policy (2.3.8) the District wants to promote individuals as ambassadors. Wearing issued apparel is a sign of pride and ownership that will enhance performance on and off the emergency scene. Being a member of this organization is a sign of utmost trust and admiration, displaying the district name in public should be done with the best of judgment. District issued apparel is for members use only. Upon leaving the District members may be asked to return all issued apparel unless otherwise stated in the below guideline. These articles of clothing are not to be donated to any charitable organization.

GUIDELINE:

1. During Orientation the following items will be issued:

- 1 – Hat (if desired)
- 2 – T-Shirts
- 1 – Fleece

When there is a need for replacement items the individual will talk to their station officer or a member of the paid staff.

2. When probation is completed the following item will be issued:

- 1 – District Winter Coat

1 year after completion of probation, ownership of the winter coat transfers from the District to the individual.
